Resolutions are committed to minimising the impact of its activities on the environment.


We ensure that we are reducing, recycling and reusing everything we can. We also encourage sub-contractors, suppliers and clients to do the same.

## **Environmental Objectives**

Our environmental objectives for this year are as follows:

	<b>Objective</b>	<b>Target</b>	<b>Deadline</b>
1	Reducing fuel usage by planning visits, vehicle sharing etc	Reduce by further 5%	October 2016
2	Sourcing our purchases from sustainable and recycled products	Increase of 10%	October 2016
3	Saving paper by printing double sided, reducing printing and sending emails instead of hard copies	Reduce paper by 10%	October 2016

We monitor the above objectives by recording fuel usage, reviewing our purchases on a bi-monthly basis and checking amount of paper purchased on a monthly basis.

We review the objectives on a regular basis and change the targets on an annual basis.

## **Current Initiatives**

### **Reduce**

- Using local suppliers to reduce our carbon footprint and support the local economy
- Photograph completed flip charts rather than photocopying them
- Efficient use of water and energy
- Minimising petrol usage by carefully planning visits
- Buy products with little packaging
- Buying non-toxic products whenever possible
- Ensuring that the last person leaving a building checks all lights and power are off
- Car sharing.

### **Reuse**

We aim to reuse our waste by:

- Reusing packaging and other materials such as
  - Paper and Envelopes
  - Cardboard, Newspaper and Bubble Wrap
  - Plastic and Paper Bags.

### **Recycle**

We recycle our waste by:

- Buying products that can be recycled
- Buying products that have been made from recycled material
- Using recycling bins
